Program learnings

- This initiative of providing Urban Transport Services through GUTSL was a 1st of its kind because previously there were only very small vehicle and autorickshaw were plying wherein people were unable to even stand properly.
- As the demand for urban transport increases so too does the popularity of the Bus services. Production of this type of motorized has doubled between the years., it is responsible for a significant share of motorized trips. Strategies to improve urban transport must include a policy vision for this increasingly important sector. To that end, this program enlightened us about the role and need of promoting sustainable urban transport in my State. It develops a policy vision for this sector and presents recommendations on reforms to address sustainability challenges.
- However with the onset of City Bus Services people got relief from the ever prevailing problems of transportation. Now people are so acquainted with this service that they cant think of without this for a day. Now seeing the success story of City Bus Services in this cluster, Govt. is thinking of creating more such clusters.

- 4) Reserve Police Ground -1st Gate.

Intercity Initiative

- 1)Brahmapur-Gopalpur (15 Kms.)
- 2) Brahmapur-Chatrapur (22 Kms).
- 3) Brahmapur-Hinjilicut (22 Kms.)
- 4) Brahmapur-Tara Tarini (35 Kms.)

Any projects/proposal

- CITY BUS DEPOT: has been constructed in the outskirts of Brahmapur City at Haladiapadar in the following land schedule.
- **AREA COVERED:** Ac.1.799, Plot No.964, 965, 966, 967, 1110(p), 1111, 1112, 1116, 1117(p), 1131(p), Khata No.337.
- PROJECT COST: Rs.2.90 Crore.
- PROVISION MADE: has been made for accommodating more than 50 Buses.
- Now GUTSL is having 32 Buses and Govt. is proposing to provide nearly 20 more Buses.

- The City Bus Services in the Brahmapur, Chatrapur, Gopalpur & Hinjilicut cluster is success story and has become the most dependable and affordable commutation by the general public.
