1. This Request for Expressions of Interest follows the general procurement notice for this project that appeared in Development Business, issue on 1 October 2008
2. The Ministry of Urban Development has received a grant from the Global Environment Fund (GEF)/ International Bank for Reconstruction and Development and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this grant to payments under the contract for '**Consultancy Services to Develop Operations Documents for Traffic Management (TMICC) and Information Control Centre and National Public Transport Helpline (NPTH)**'.
3. The objective of this consultancy is to:
 - (i) Help develop a comprehensive "generic" operations manuals with system design and architecture for the following:
 - a. Traffic Information and Management Control Centre (TIMCC); and
