UNDP, New Delhi (India) invites interested companies/consultants to apply on the following:

Summary of proposal:

The Government of India (GoI) has initiated the Sustainable Urban Transport Project (SUTP) with support of Global Environment Facility (GEF), UNDP and the World Bank. The objective of the project is to facilitate the provision of urban transport infrastructure and services in a manner that is consistent with sustainable environmental considerations and the National Urban Transport Policy (NUTP). The Ministry of Urban Development (MoUD) has been appointed as the nodal agency for the implementation of the project.

In the last decade, there is a realization among the States and Municipal bodies responsible for supporting urban transport that adequate capacity does not exist to combat the growing transportation problems in their jurisdictions. The subcomponent 2 of SUTP aims at establishing the needed capacity for regular skill development of public officials, other public functionaries and urban professionals in the field of urban transport to be able to find solutions for the above stated problems and apply the skills in planning.

Institute of Urban Transport (IUT) shall undertake the sub component and it is proposed to engage a suitable agency, termed as Project Consultant 2 (PC2), to assist IUT in developing the required training material and the trainers.

Objectives and outputs:

The objective of the stated consultancy is to secure the services of a team/agency to develop 10 subject modules and kits for trainers, on a collection of topics associated with sustainable urban transport planning. The modules are to be developed with learning objectives to understand the growing problems of urban transport and the

key issues involved. The module will seek to bring about an understanding of the remedial measures being taken globally and the challenges in implementing them. It is proposed to develop up to 10 trainers in each subject module. The assignment must commence from April/May'2011 and is to be completed in a period of 80 weeks.

Submission Requirements:
